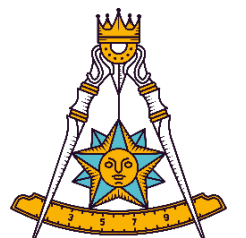

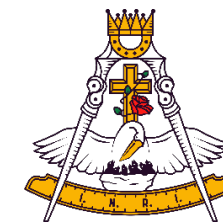

Feast of the Paschal Lamb



Join us at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday February 1, 2026, at the Greater Pittsburgh Masonic Center as the Pittsburgh Chapter of Rose Croix observes the beautiful and symbolic celebration of the Feast of the Paschal Lamb as a memorial service, honoring our Brethren who have passed to their eternal reward during the preceding year. In spirit, we seem to sense their presence at the Mystic Banquet as we seek to strengthen the ties of brotherly love which bind our hearts in holy remembrance.

The Feast of the Paschal Lamb is neither the Feast of the Passover nor the institution of the Sacrament of Holy Communion, although it commemorates both holy days. In the fellowship of kindred minds, we meet to express our faith as symbolically we break the bread and drink the wine of fraternal love, becoming aware once more that the only hope of a better world still abides in the simple command of our great Exemplar, "Love one another."

Family, friends and non-Masons are welcome to attend. The dress code is business casual, and light refreshments will be served following the ceremony. Reservations are not necessary but are appreciated to help plan the refreshments.
